

# Chaplain's Words of Wisdom



**FATHER ANTON'S WORDS WISDOM:** The readings that follow Easter Sunday are to prepare us for that. wonderful feast of Pentecost when we will celebrate the birth, of the Church. Before Jesus left, he promised the disciples that his Father would send them the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus knew that the disciples would struggle without Him, but he also knew that for them to grow and for the Church to develop, He would have to let go. In a practical way of thinking, it isn't unlike parents who, once their children have reached a certain age, have to let go so they could spread their wings and find their own way in life. The early Church was on fire! The Resurrection was such a current event that faith was strong, hope was everywhere and the disciples and leaders of various Christian communities were doing wonderful things. One would have to ask: What happened? Where is that strong faith today? Where are God's hope-filled people? How have we as Church in our modern society responded to the fire of the Holy Spirit? In the reading from the Acts, we hear how Peter went to the leader of one of the early Christian communities to heal them. The disciples name was Tabitha and we are told that she lived her life in service to the poor and in good deeds. The people continued to experience resurrection! John in his gospel relates to us a story of the healing of a paralyzed man. If you listen carefully it was the man who came to Jesus, and Jesus asks him if he wants to be well. The man then relates how he has no one to put him into the pool of water known for healing powers, so Jesus simply says: "Take up your mat and walk." Immediately he does and it was the Sabbath Day. Admonished by the religious leaders because the man was carrying his mat on the Sabbath, the man relates what happened to him. Jesus, upon seeing him again reminds the man who was healed: "Look, you are well, do not sin anymore, so that nothing worse may happen to you." In other words; "You have been made whole, see to it that you keep a healthy balance in your life and that you nurture the Spiritual as much, if not more, than your physical and emotional needs. In this way you will always be in tune with who you are as God's child, and you will never feel abandoned in your time of need." It was not the water in the pool that healed this man, it was his faith. The water was just a catalyst to remind him of God's mercy. It is so important for us to understand that while this story related to us another of the healing miracles of Jesus, there is another

very important message between the lines. It is easy for us to see through our "physical eyes" when all is going well, but in time, in all of our lives something will come that will cloud that vision. These events or situations may be physical illness, relationships that are broken, a crisis in faith, or hard times that befall us for one reason for another. At these times in our lives if we rely only on the "eyes of our mind" to guide us, we too, will suffer from blindness. It is in these situations that we need to pray "Jesus, give me spiritual eyes that I might be able to let go of what was, accept what is and start to heal; so that I can experience fully and with joy what it yet to come. Jesus, give me your eyes so I can see beyond my pain and experience God's presence and faithfulness." Prayer is nothing more than talking to our loving Saviour and admitting our helplessness at times. It helps us to understand our humanity and to embrace it so that we can experience God working and acting at every moment and in every situation. It is true that all of us experience suffering, and at one time or another we have been deeply hurt or allowed ourselves to wallow over petty things to the point where we become paralyzed. We cannot be free unless we let go of the past and learn the true meaning of forgiveness. We must let go of the past that we wish we had, in order to live in the present. Living in the present we must step back in every situation so that we can see the "whole picture" and understand that today is all we have. We can choose to live it holding on to grudges and past hurts, or we can let them go so that we can be free. The healing stories of Jesus are about understanding that illness is not a result of sin, but rather our hopelessness is. It is about understanding that our emotions affect our physical and our spiritual health more than we think. When we can't let go, when we refuse to forgive, physically our blood pressure rises, the stress can affect our heart, our mental health, and can even be a contributor to cancer, migraines, and other diseases. Spiritually we are dead. Our attitudes, wallowing in self-pity and often our choice to live in anger affects our relationship with God, and therefore, with each other. We cannot experience forgiveness if we refuse to forgive, we cannot experience love unless we are willing to love. You and I must have faith and trust there is nothing that we cannot handle. Life can throw us many curve balls, but we are able to catch them and throw them back. Even if we miss and one of those balls hits us again, we will not despair, because our God will help us to heal and to become even stronger through our trial.

#### LET US PRAY:

Loving God, heal me of all those things that prevent me from experiencing and embracing your love and mercy. And through me heal others who need to know that life is more than our past, it is a gift that is to be lived NOW. I will from this day forward let go of what was, accept what is, and live my life with and through You – Amen.

Those conflicts and disputes among you, where do they come from? Do they not come from your cravings that are at war within you? You want something and do not have it; so you commit murder. And you covet/something and cannot obtain it; so you engage in disputes and conflicts. You do not have, because you do not ask. You ask and you do not receive, because you ask wrongly, in order to spend what you get on your pleasures. Adulterers! Do you know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. Or do you suppose that it is nothing that the scripture says, 'God yearns jealously for the spirit that he has made to dwell in us'? But he gives all the more grace; therefore it says, 'God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.' Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Lament and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy into dejection. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.


